



AUSTRALIA DAY AWARDS

CITIZEN OF THE YEAR

As is customary, Council will present the Citizen of the Year Award. The presentation ceremony will be held at Boree Creek on Australia Day, 26th January, 2010.

Council is now seeking nominations from community organisations of suitable persons who would be considered worthy of this award.

Nominees may have served their local organisation or organisations outside the community which benefit others apart from local residents. The service may be only for a short period of time or it may represent many years of effort. Acts of compassion, generosity, bravery and individual service can also be taken into account.

Conditions of Nomination

- a) All citizens associated with the Shire are eligible for nomination. (Excluding Councillors, their families and senior Council staff and families.)
- b) Nominations can only be made by recognised organisations within the Shire.
- c) **Nominations close at 5.00 p.m. on Friday 27th November 2009**, and should be addressed to the General Manager, Urana Shire Council, PO Box 55, Urana NSW 2645.
- d) Nominations need to be in the form of a letter giving the name of the nominee together with supporting details of the nominee's service to the community.

The Citizen of the Year Award is a very prestigious award presented annually, which is an acknowledgment Australia wide of the particular recipient's contribution to his or her respective communities.

All organisations within the Shire are asked to give this award serious consideration. Your support of the award by submitting suitable nominees will ensure the ongoing recognition of valued contributors to the Shire Community.
